Michael Dean Church Signs with EMC for PR



Nashville, TN – EMC Director of PR & Artist Development, Diana Henderson announced today the signing of Michael Dean Church for PR representation. EMC will be working on behalf of Church to promote his soon to be released project, "Live It Out Loud."



Michael Dean Church, was born in the small coal mining town of Welch , West Virginia . The hard lifestyle of a coalminer, and a subsequent injury to his father, lead the family to relocate to Rome , GA. Church developed his musical style by combining what he heard in his heart first with the musical influences he heard on the radio. It was normal for Church to enjoy bluegrass one moment, and then switch to a blues or country feel next. He honed his skills and developed his style as a singer working in local Georgia night clubs. Soon, it was obvious to Church that moving to Nashville would be his next step.



After living in Nashville for only a short time, Michael Dean Church was introduced to veteran music producer Steven Sharp of Sharp Objects. Impressed with Michael Dean Church's talent, Sharp agreed to produce his project, but wanted to fit the 'voice' to the 'studio.' In a unique move, Sharp and Church made the decision to record in the studio of the legendary Buck Owens in Bakersfield, CA. Michael Dean Church found himself sitting on an airplane, heading for California. Taking it a step further, Buck Owens' longtime back-up band, The Buckaroo's, were invited to play on the tracks, creating an authentic "Bakersfield" sound.

With movie star good looks combined with 'down-home' mannerisms and a charming personality, this six-foot-five heartthrob is sure to become a household name.
