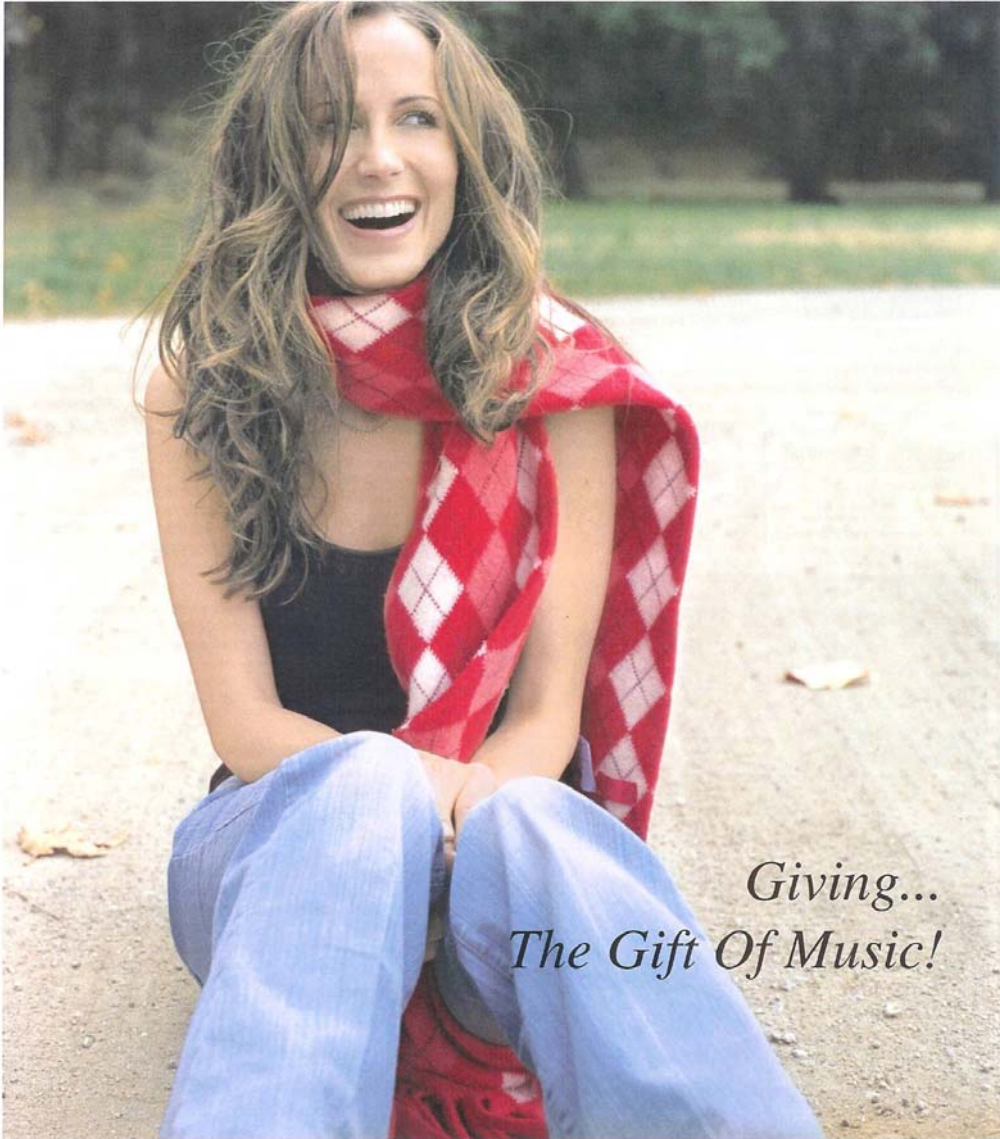

One look at Michael Dean Church and you may think that he looks like Zack on *Saved By The Bell*. Just like Zack, Michael has the same sassy, get into trouble, persona. However, his personality consists of a bit more.

Michael Dean Church was raised in the deep southern hospitality of Georgia. His Georgian accent brings a gentle mix to his vocal abilities. Abilities that showcase blues, bluegrass, gospel and country crooning.

Last December, Church released his debut album, *Live It Out Loud*. This project, released on Dream Church Records, consists of eleven incredible songs.

The album opens with the title track. A catchy tune that features an

electric attitude. A song that makes the list of theme or signature songs.

Michael displays another vocal ability in "Fools Like Us." This masterpiece proves that Church can sing the heartfelt ballads with the best of them. A beautiful mix of his southern crooning vocals, background vocals and instrumentals that is sure to measure up to Tim McGraw status.

The album continues with another catchy tune in "Love's In The Making." Church performs this one as if he were floating in the clouds. The song's light and airy feel is sure to cheer up anyone with a heavy heart. This song is synonymous with those performed by Garth Brooks.

The next cut brings another heartfelt ballad. "What Am I Crying For" may make our list of Top Songs of 2006. Michael performs this with such heart and soul. The emotion just pours out of the speakers. It's as if he re-lives the song each time he performs it.

"I can relate to that song,

because I went through a bad breakup in the past," replied Church. "That song kinda hit home with me when I first heard it."

However, I do believe that the song would go farther as a duet then as a solo.

Another great song is "Forget About Love." This song has a wonderful smooth country feeling. It is synonymous with the songs that were performed by country artists of the '80's. It is good to hear a song like this again! One of my favorites.

Church returns to the ballads with "Is That You." A song that I feel is not quite his style. Perhaps, it's the way the music was written.

The song that is sure to gain attention is "I Won't Run." This song is true to country music. It's touch of outlaw country mixed with an electric feel brings this one to the top. If I were to pick a song for a video, it would be this one!

"Don't Let The Night End," is a beautiful ballad of love. Michael brings a soulful feeling to this song. Another that showcases his vast talents mixed with pure emotion.

Listeners will find a great guitar rift in "Oh Linda." Another toe tapping, catchy tune. One that is sure to stick in your head. It sounds as if Church enjoys performing these type of songs more than the ballads.

"Another Only One" is a heart break ballad. I respect Michael's decision to record this song in the style that he did. However, I believe that this one would be better if he were to slow it down and emphasise the heartache.

The album ends with "Burned By The Same Fire Twice." This one brings out his version of the traditional Bakersfield sound.

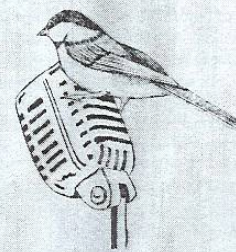
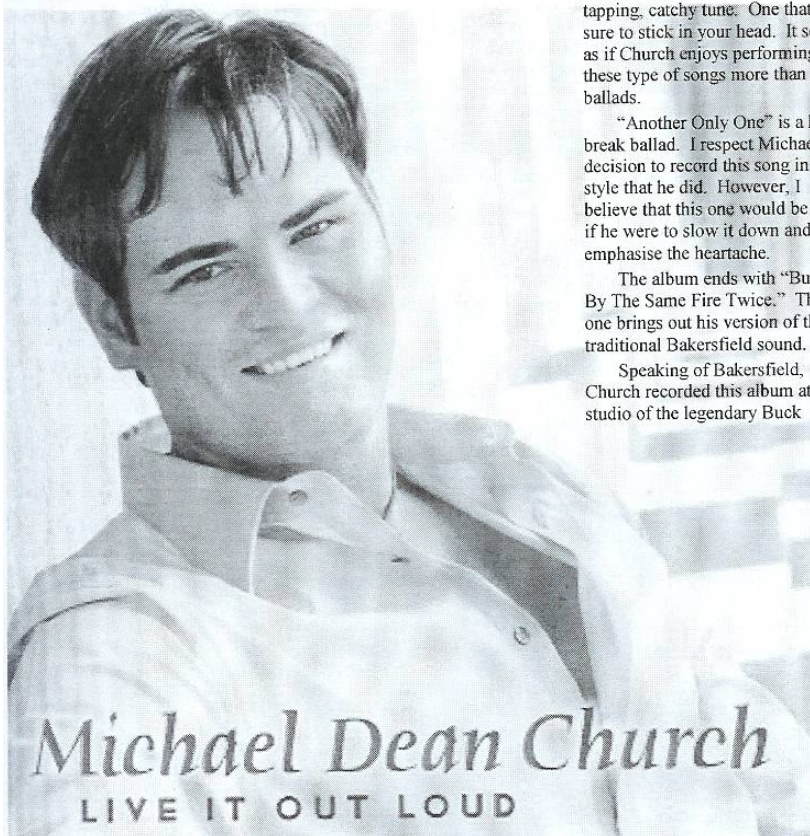
Speaking of Bakersfield, Church recorded this album at the studio of the legendary Buck

Owens, in Bakersfield, California. This new talent was backed by Buck Owen's longtime back-up band, The Buckaroo's. Thus truly creating an unique but true Bakersfield sound.

His style can only be described as southern twang mixed with '80's style country. In better terms, he's Garth Brooks and Clint Black mixed with a touch of Jeff Foxworthy. Now top that off with Dwight Yoakam and Buck Owens. It's a different but a pleasantly unique sound.
